- 1. The safety of this lighting fixture is guaranteed only if you comply with these insturctions.
- 2. Please use the specific input voltage.
- 3. Please disconnect the power before repair, installation or replacement.
- 4.Please also make sure the correct connection between the wires of the light and the mains power cables' positive pole and negative pole before turn on the power.
- 5.Please use the lights in the proper application places as to avoid the lights be broken.
- 6. Do not locate fixtures in low areas where water will collect.
- 7. Whatever the case is, the lamp is not to be insulated liner or similar materials cover.
- 8. Attention! Please connect the wiring port well with the cables to prevent leakage of electricity .
- 9. Protection against electric shock: Class I(must be earthed)
- 10. If any questions on this instruction, please consult a professional qualified technicians.

■Instructions of installation.

- 1. Ensure mains supply is switched off during the whole installation period. Disconnect the power supply to all of those units.
- 2. Please check below drawing and specifications. You should install the mounting box firstly during constructing the wall, and make the wires for the fixtures.
- 3. Connect the electric supply wires of "L", "N", "Ground" to the corresponding "L", "N", "Ground" of the fixture's wires with the waterproof connector IP65 at least in parallel circuit.
- 4. Push the fixture into the mounting box.
- 5. Ensure everything is installed very well, and then turn on the power for the application.

Note: The power of main supply must be switched off before connecting the cables.




