

When rhythm is playing, press Insert to add the door function for rhythm. When finish playing this section rhythm, it will insert a door interlude.

5.Chord accompaniment 1) Single finger chord Single has function only under rhythm mode and general mode.

• Under rhythm play mode, press this key and any key in the range of C3~F4#, then press single fingering you will hear the relevant chord accompaniment. This fingering can be used together with rhythm.

• Finger has function only under rhythm mode and general mode. While playing rhythm, press this key and any key in the range of C3~F4#, then press finger, you will hear the relevant chord accompaniment. if not pressing finger, it will not play chord rhythm.

ssing **REC** will make it enter into recording mode, and then press any key or tum key, it will start to record. The maximum record is 92, once it is full, you will cannot continue to record next musical note. You can press > at any moment to play record while recording.

• Every time pressing REC will delete the memory last time and again enter into recording mode.

• Pressing OOP will make it enter into OOP mode, and the default speed is 120. • Can record the drum sound pressed, and under OOP mode, it can record drum sound and keyboard

drum (piano key will automatically switch into keyboard drum). The most record is 32, and once it is full, it will cannot continue to record next drum sound. You can press > at any moment to play drum sound recorded.

• Every time pressing OOP will delete the memory last time and again enter into OOP mode.

 Play program:can play all drum sound and repeat play. • Play record:can play the musical note and drum sound recorded at the selected tone while recording.

Pressing will have no act if there is no previous record value.

1)Tone change:

 Sustain:press Sustain to extend the end time of piano key sound. Vibrato:press Vibrato to make piano key sound has trebling effect.

1)Teaching(OKON): • Pressing OKON will make it enter into teaching mode, then press white key to select different songs, and after playing song, whichever key user press, it will be the main melody.
